This is **AJ** sending a friendly reminder and informational message, regarding **cleaning your tanning bed!** In as few as 7 steps you can have a clean, dust free tanning bed! *****Detailed cleaning instructions can be found on the next page. *****

This process should be done about every 2 to 3 months and will take approximately 30minutes.

- 1 First of all you will need to remove and clean the acrylics.
- 2 Next remove and clean the bulbs.
- 3 Next you will want to vacuum the dust and other particles that have accumulated inside of the tanning bed.
- 4 Wipe the reflectors with a dry or damp cloth.
- 5 Now place the bulbs back into the lamp holders in the bed.
- 6 TEST THE BED TO MAKE SURE ALL OF THE BULBS LIGHT CORRECTLY!
- 7 Now you can replace the acrylics starting with the bottom then the top.

Detailed cleaning process

1. First of all you will need to remove the acrylics (the 'glass' the tanners lay on) if you are not familiar with this process see the picture below 😊 After you have removed the acrylics stand them against a wall, concave side toward the wall, this will allow you to easily clean the "underside" of the acrylics, do this the same as you would clean the "top" side (concave) after tanning. Easy enough, right!?! ****be sure to place towels on the top corners of the acrylics... This will prevent them from, A. scratching the walls, and B. poking triangular holes at eyelevel in your walls. Not good 😞 ****
2. Remove the bulbs... starting with the bottom bulbs first... The tanning bulbs remove just like regular florescent light bulbs... That is just turn the bulbs and lift them out of the holders. After you have removed the bulbs you can clean them. You can either clean them one at a time after you take them out or one at a time before you put them back in.
3. Repeat step #2. With the top of the tanning bed.
4. Next you will want to vacuum the dust and other particles that have accumulated inside of the tanning bed. **DO NOT attempt to vacuum between the bulbs with the crevasse attachment! Undoubtedly this will cause bulbs to break! Use plain hose or upholstery attachment!**
5. After you have vacuumed THOROUGHLY you should wipe the reflectors with a dry or damp cloth... ***DO NOT USE BED CLEANER*** this will cause **massive amounts of streaking** and will reduce the quality of the tan your clients receive! Use plain water only, and only a small amount... ensure the cloth is damp.
6. If you have not yet cleaned your bulbs you can do so now, just give them a light spray with your bed cleaner and a good wipe down with a clean cloth... Depending on how long it has been since you have cleaned your bed you may need to change cloths somewhere along the line of bulbs, use your discretion on this 😊
7. Once the bulbs are clean you can place them back into the lamp holders in the bed, I recommend after giving them a good wipe down just put them back... Starting once again with the bottom immediately after cleaning them, no reason to make two piles of bulbs.

8. Ok now you have the bed clean of dust and other stuff ***TEST THE BED TO MAKE SURE ALL OF THE BULBS LIGHT CORRECTLY! IF THEY DO NOT, PLEASE CALL US, WE WILL ASSIST YOU IN CORRECTING THIS PROBLEM☺***
9. Finally replace the acrylics starting with the bottom then the top. For the top you will most likely need to either lie on the bottom or use the bottom acrylic for some leverage helping you to hold the top in place, this is why you should secure the bottom acrylic first.

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
